

Counting the Homer for Sunday evening, June 5 through Monday evening, June 6

1. Each evening, recite the blessing:

בָּרוּךְ אַתָּה ה' אֱלֹהֵינוּ מֶלֶךְ הָעוֹלָם אֲשֶׁר קִדְּשָׁנוּ בְּמִצְוֹתָיו וְצִוָּנוּ עַל סְפִירַת הָעֹמֶר

*Baruch atah adonay eloheynu melech ha'olam asher kidshanu bemitzvotav
vetzivanu al sefirat ha'omer*

Blessed are you, ETERNAL, our God, the sovereign of all worlds, who has made us holy with your mitzvot and commanded us concerning the counting of the Omer.

2. Count the Homer for each day:



For Sunday evening, June 5 through Monday, June 6:

48. הַיּוֹם שְׁמוֹנֶה וָאַרְבָּעִים יוֹם שֶׁהֵם שִׁשָּׁה שָׁבוּעוֹת וְשִׁשָּׁה יָמִים לְעֹמֶר

*Hayom shemonah v'arba'im yom, sh'hem shishah shavuot
v'shishah yamim la'omer.*

Today is the forty-eighth day, making six weeks and six days of the Omer.



For Monday evening, June 6 through Tuesday, June 7:

49. הַיּוֹם תִּשְׁעָה וָאַרְבָּעִים יוֹם שֶׁהֵם שִׁבְעָה שָׁבוּעוֹת לְעֹמֶר

Hayom tishah v'arba'im yom, sh'hem shivah shavuot la'omer.

Today is the forty-ninth day, making seven weeks of the Omer.
